Event Details

Chess Tournament:

A. Individual – Each game should be of 10minutes, timer and chess set would be given from here, the system is Swiss league

B. team- there should be 4 persons in a team, draw gains half points, win-1point, lose-0 points after the match we'll count total point of the four member and publish the result.

N.B:- Participation limit 180.

Chess Quiz:

This time we bring up to you a new genre of quiz. In this event, participants will be given 30 questions regarding augment history, Simple rules grandmaster, puzzle and some other info regarding the aristocratic game. The participants will be given 30 minutes for answering the question.

IQ TEST:

“Hard work eventual solves all problems but to solve problems quickly you need intelligence.”

This is one of the exclusive event that is brought up to you by JCC this will be acute measuring stick of an individual's IQ. The participants will be provided with a set of questions which will comprise of 20 tricky questions off which some will be picture based, some will be on situation will based .in a word you have to give all that you have stored up in your brain to be the best. The participants will be given 30mins for answering the questions. The result will be given along with official scores.

Photographic Memory Quiz:

To add more glaze to the events and to test eidetic memory of the participants, we came up with this outstanding contest. In this event, the participants will be shown some short video clips regarding any topic. Then they have some questions regarding the clips .The participants with the most correct answers will be declared as the winners

Cryptic Crosswords:

This is another exclusive event of JCC where the participants will be provided with a cryptic crosswords .this is the first time coming up out of the traditional method of crosswords, this event of crosswords is being hosted. It is type of crossword in

which each clue is a puzzle itself. The participants have to solve them correctly in order to get the correct answers. For this, they will get 30mins time. The participants with the most correct answers within the shortest time will be declared winners.

Sudoku:

“Our whole life is solving puzzles”, Erno Rubik

JCC has come up with this event to test the puzzle solving ability of students. There will be a box comprising of 9*9 tiles filled with numbers. The participants have to fill up from 1-9. 30minutes will be given for solving the problem.

The person taking the least time will win.

Criminal Identification:

We have added this exclusive event in our event list to test how much advanced your detectives skills are. The participants will be shown some video clips regarding different criminal cases and some crime scenes. Then they have to answer the questions regarding the clips and crime scenes. Again, some stories portraying criminal cases will be given in your question papers as stem and from there you have to find clues using your detective skills and answer the question. You will be given 1 hour for answering 30 questions

Trove Chase:

This is simplified from treasure hunting. It will be conducted into two rounds. Treasure. For example, treasure hunters try to find sunken shipwrecks and retrieve artifacts with market value. Well, we can't do that in our campus can we?? No certainly not. But we can have fun finding out what is hidden. Join us on this immense and joyful hunt. Let's see who has the brains to find out what we've hidden. So buckle up and start searching. You will be provided with several clues for each team leading to one treasure, you are ready mates, are you??

Basic Information:

.Each team should have 4 members. They can also form team consisting of 3 members.

2. 10 teams will qualify in the second round.

Logic Battle:

‘WORDS CAN SAVE THE WORLD’

We do things in Daily life which may have base or not. Logic is something which helps us analyze different aspects giving us a sense of judgement. Logic battle is such an event that develops this sense of judgement. Here participants will get a definite amount of time to talk on a topic which will be provided some minutes before the event. Then his competitor will again get the same amount time to give logic against him. In a word, it is familiar as one vs one debate.

General Knowledge Quiz:

This is the team event where the participants have to depict how much enriched their general knowledge are. The event consists of two round. The first will be written round where the participating teams have to answer 25 questions. To answer these 25 questions, the teams will be given 30 minutes. After that the top 5 teams will be selected for the next round. The next round will be buzzer round. The top 3 teams with highest scores will be declared winners successively. In each team, there will be 3 members.

Rubik's Cube Competition:

Basic Rules:

1. Competitors must complete registration before the deadline.
2. Registration must be done through WCA website page of the competition and all the criteria and clauses given by the organizers should be followed.
3. Competitors must bring their own cubes.
4. Registration link will be provided through our event page.
5. for confusion during event, WCA Delegate's decision final
6. WCA events always happen within given time and takes place in time. So competitors must arrive and report in the competition in time. Else he/she may lose the chance participate and won't get any registration back.

All the participants will receive certificates and their result will be counted as official result and will be ranked globally.
