- 6. Decisions taken by the authority and judge will be the final decisions. Objections should be notified to the science club.
- 7. Online registration is available. Participant can also register by the invitation letter. Registration and other necessary information are given at the last page.
- 8. Those who completed their registration through online need not to do registration by the invitation letter again.
- 9. Registration will be packed up after the maximum number of each event.
- 10. Participants of each competition must report at least 20 minutes before the competition brings on that very day.
- 11. Participants are requested to bring their necessary equipment with them.

• Truss Challenge Rules

A competition of pop stick made bridge.

- 1. Group: IX-XII
- 2. Maximum 3 participants will pair up a team.
- 3. Popsicle sticks will be provided on spot.
- 4. Each should bring only one glue gun(for use), glue and a multi-plug.
- 5. Only 350 Popsicle sticks will be provided.
- 6. Stick count must be recorded and presented to the judges
- 7. 3 members of a team must be from same institution.
- 8. All teams must be ready to prepare their model within 3 hours.
- 9. Maximum clear length of 38-42cm and Joint length can't be more than 1 cm
- 10. Inner width of the truss must be at least 8 cm.
- 11. Popsicle sticks can't be cut & use of broken stick is not allowed.
- 12. Glue can only be used on joints. If it is used anywhere else, then that truss will be disqualified. The sticks may be placed diagonally but glue MUST NOT be applied at the diagonally overlapped Popsicle.
- 13. Overlapping (one stick over other) of two sticks is not allowed. Any truss having this will be disqualified.
- 14. To allow for testing, there must be a .5" gap at mid-span in the bridge deck.
- 15. There must be no obstructions below the hole that would prevent the passage of the testing apparatus(rod)
- 16. Scoring: Total points= (Load taken/ Self weight) (Numbers of Overlapping x 2) (Numbers of excess glue x 5)
- 17. Maximum 1 teams can participate form an institution.


